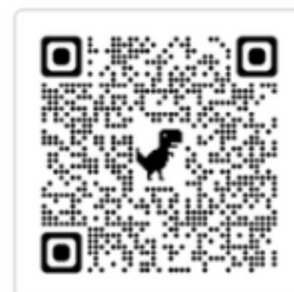

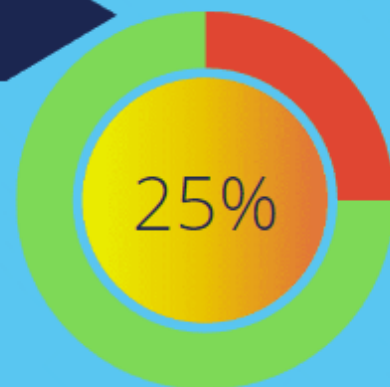
# Focus on Positive Behaviour for Learning

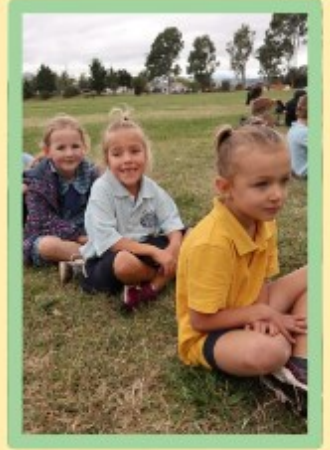
