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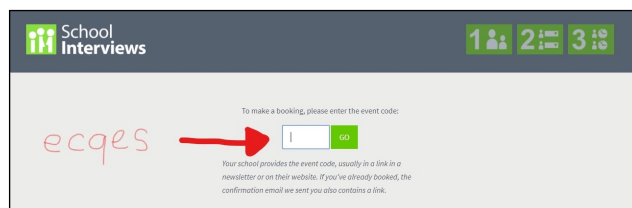
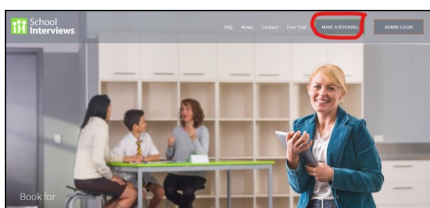

Jump Rope for Heart

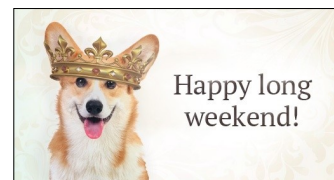
Next Friday 14th June, we will be holding our Jump Rope for Heart Jump Off!

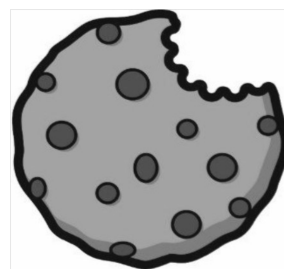
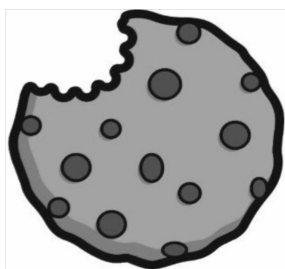
