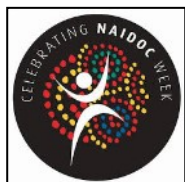
Dear Families,

Footsteps



This is our second year engaging with the Footsteps program. They specialise in school dance programs where dance is used as a vehicle to develop students' social skills, confidence and creativity. Over three lessons and a disco, students experience various dance styles including hip hop, funk, modern pop, contemporary, partner and various multicultural dances

from around the world. The school Disco which will be on 27th June in our school hall. The disco times are K-2 from 5:00pm-6:00pm and Yr 3-6 from 6:00pm-7:30pm, the admission cost is already included in the Footsteps program. Our school has subsidised the cost of this program for each child by paying half of the \$20 per child. Therefore each child is only required to pay \$10 to participate. Please ensure we receive your payment by next Friday. At present we have only 106 students who have paid.
