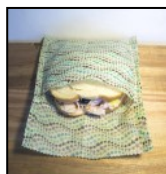
I wish our team well for this Friday's District Athletics Carnival. Let's hope for a warm, sunny day!

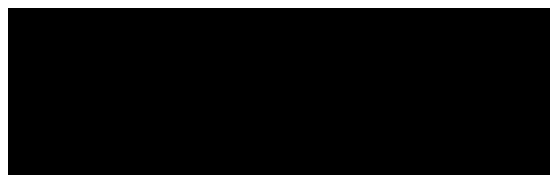
