Welfare System - Trial

Our PBL committee recently met and discussed how difficult it was for students on 'B level' to get off it. It was nearly impossible, as students had to go six weeks without a further misdemeanour. In light of this fact we are trialling a revised timeline for students in terms of being placed on B level and then to get themselves off B level.

The trial timeframe is:

- 3 Blue Book entries within a 4 week period will place a student on B level (formerly a 6 week period)
- Zero Blue book entries or 'minors' within a 2 week period will see students return to A level. (formerly a 6 week period)

We will trial this for Term 2 and revise it if necessary.
