As the end of the year is quickly approaching, Home Reading has now finished for 2019.

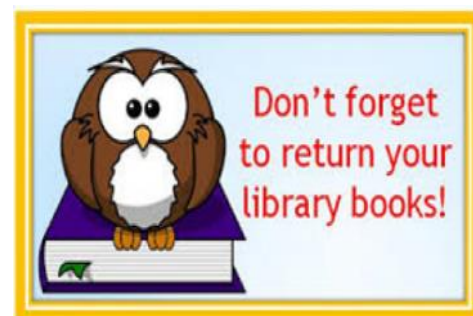
I ask that all library books and home readers now be returned to school.
