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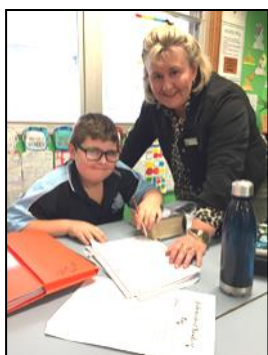


**Term 2, Week 2, 6th May 2020**

## **Student Rostered Days Commencing Next Week (Week 3) 11 May**

## **Dropping Off and Up Students – Safety Measures**

Can I please ask that parents who drop their children to school and pick them up from school, to **not** enter the school grounds unless absolutely necessary. I also request that we don't have parents chatting in groups outside the school gate areas, please adhere to social distancing measures.



## **Student Work Pack Return and Collection**

Parents will be able to return their child's study pack #2 (Weeks 1 and 2) from this Friday onwards. Individual class return boxes will be placed on the blue seats outside the administration buildings for you to do this each day from 9:00am-3:30pm. Any parents who are returning these on Friday of this week will also be able to pick up their child's next fortnightly study pack from the following locations:

Kinder – Mr McBryde's room

Years 1 and 2 – Mr Prior's room

Years 3 and 4 and 4/5 Brown – Mrs Rayner's room

Years 5 and 6 – Mrs Connell's room

Students who are attending their rostered day at school next Monday will be provided with their work pack on Monday. Any parent needing their child's study pack mailed out can call the school to request this.
