Our whole school **Home Reading Policy** encourages all children K - 6 to read at least 4 nights a week. Home Reading aims to increase confidence, fluency and expression as well as a love of reading which will continue into later life. Children in K-2 borrow books from the School's Home Reading Library. Children in Years 3 - 6 are encouraged to read the books they borrow from the School, Town Library or books they have at home.
