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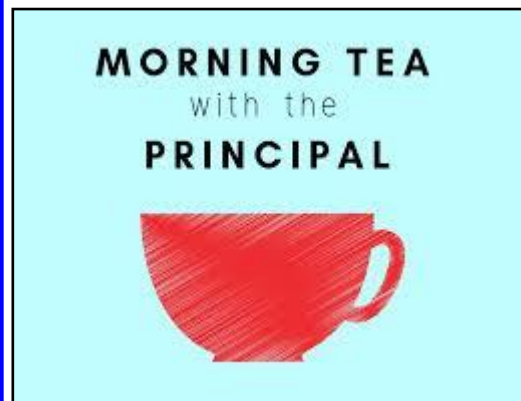

IMPORTANT

External Visitor - Sign In

A procedure that has commenced last week, Monday 15th June, is the 'External Visitors to School Site form.' This form must be signed by all visitors to our school. It is to ensure that all external providers and essential visitors to our school **each day**, demonstrate compliance with health and safety requirements, including adhering to strict guidelines and completing relevant forms. Any parent that has an essential need to attend school, such as to attend a meeting, collect an unwell child, purchase a hat, sign a late child into school or pick up a child early from school, will be required to sign this form.

This form requires a name and contact phone/email address to be provided. This needs to occur as part of contact tracing and is an Australian Health Protection Principal Committee (AHPPC) and NSW Health requirement.
