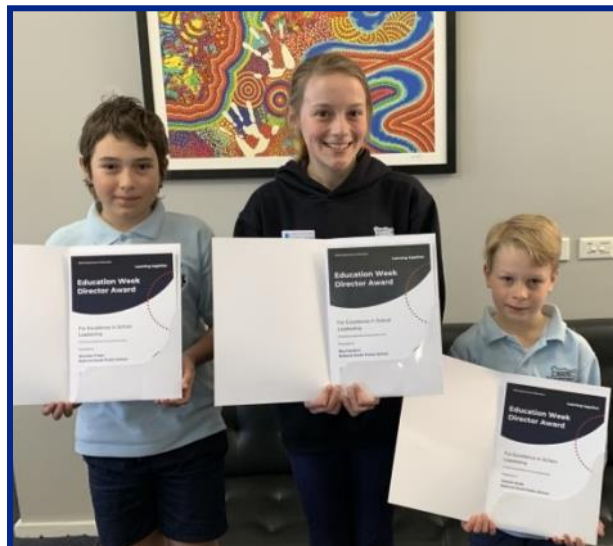
Dear Families,

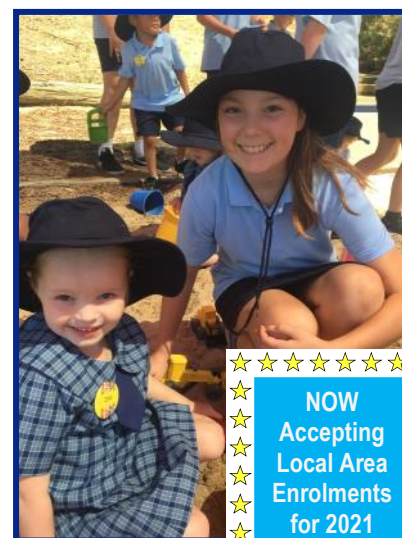
Handballs!
